

## AGING NETWORK CHORE (ANC)

Mainly for chore services, but can include personal care assistance as well.



**Client must be 60 years or older**  
**4 - 8 hours per month**

(hours do not carry over into the following month)  
 Additional hours may be available in exceptional cases

*A Community Services Specialist assesses annually to create client care plan*

- Based on client's gross monthly income, may require co-pay.
- Married couple must have less than \$15,000 in resources
- Single individual must have less than \$10,000 in resources

## FAMILY CAREGIVER SUPPORT PROGRAM (FCSP)

FCSP is designed for individuals who are the primary unpaid caregiver for a family member or friend.



**Unpaid family caregiver & care receiver must be 18 years or older**  
**36 hours respite per quarter (12 hours per month)**

Additional respite is available in exceptional cases

*Eligibility is determined through a screen & assessment which evaluates stressors and challenges the unpaid caregiver is experiencing*

- Respite Co-pay determination:
  - For unmarried care receiver - Apply SCSA Fee Schedule to his or her gross monthly income
  - For married couples - Combine couple's gross monthly income and divide it by half; then apply the SCSA Fee Schedule for a one-person household to the amount
- No resource limit
- Incontinence supplies, medical equipment & other services do not have a co-pay

ANC & FCSP programs provide assistance with Instrumental Activities of Daily Living (IADL), such as:



**Housekeeping**  
**Laundry**  
**Shopping**  
**Transportation**  
**Meal Preparation**

Additional assistance with Activities of Daily Living (ADL) may also be provided. ADLs include:

**Bathing**  
**Dressing**  
**Walking**  
**Personal Hygiene**  
**Medication Management**



Co-pay is based on care receiver's gross monthly income & assets (see SCSA Fee Schedule on back) which is calculated by multiplying percentage shown on scale by the \*current hourly rate.

\*Caregiving hourly rate varies
